

Instructions for start 2

Mass starts

The competitor comes behind the maps three (3) minutes before the start time. The competitor resets Emit card before the start. There is a reset unit at the start.

H21EB and D21EB classes

There is an interval start in these classes.

- 3 minutes before the start: the competitor will be called to the starting grid. There is a reset unit for Emit cards. A competitor is responsible for resetting his/her own Emit card and for the correct number of the Emit card.
- 2 minutes before the start: the competition map without courses can be seen.
- 1 minute before the start: the competitor moves next to the map of his/her class.
- The map can be taken at the moment of the start. The route to the start point (i.e. K point) is marked.

Children's start: 14 and younger

There is a starting grid. There is about one minute interval between the starting times. The competitor can come to the starting grip when he/she wants. There is a maximum of two competitors starting at the same time. Competitors from the same class/course can't start at the same time. There is an arranger helping if needed.

- 4 minutes before the start: the competitor comes to the starting grid. There is the competition map without the courses visible.
- 3 minutes before the start: Emit card number are checked.
- 2 minutes before the start: There is the competition map with the courses visible. The competitors in the RR classes get their maps and guidance if needed.
- 1 minute before the start: the other competitors get their maps.
- After the start sound the competitor resets his/her Emit card and starts the competition.
- The timing starts when resetting the Emit card.

Other classes in the start 2: free start

There is a starting grid. There is about one minute interval between the starting times. The competitor can come to the starting grip when he/she wants. There is a maximum of two competitors starting at the same time. Competitors from the same class/course can't start at the same time. There is an arranger helping if needed.

- 3 minutes before the start: The competitor comes to the starting grid. The competitor is responsible that his/her Emit number is correct.
- 2 minutes before the start: the competition map without courses can be seen.
- 1 minute before the start: the competitor waits for the starting sound.
- After the starting sound the competitor resets his/her Emit card, takes the right map and starts the competition.
- The timing starts when resetting the Emit card.
